MAINTENANCE & CARE

- Sweep your floor regularly to remove loose dirt.
- After sweeping, use a damp mop with a pH neutral cleaner for routine cleaning.
- Mop up spills promptly to prevent stains.
- Your vinyl's manufacturer does recommend certain cleaners for certain products. Please see your warranty information for suggested routine and intensive cleaners.
- Avoid the use of household cleaners and bleach-based detergents. Do not use doap or detergent cleaning products as they may leave a film behind or dull the vinyl surface.
- Caution: Vinyl can be slippery when wet!

PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

- Place non-staining mats or area rugs at all exterior entrances to prevent dirt and soil from being tracked onto your floor. Be certain to clean those mats often so they keep the outside from coming in.
- Support furniture with non-staining floor protectors.
- If you need to move heavy furniture or appliances, be sure to lift before moving to protect your floor from gouges.
- Direct sunlight can be harmful; may fade or discolor vinyl. Shut shades on occasion to help prevent damage.

DID YOU KNOW?

After installation, traffic must be kept light as the adhesive dries. Avoid walking on your new floor for the first 24 hours so that the adhesive can dry properly.

CLEANING VINYL

- Although sweeping will remove loose dirt, it will not remove the oily, sticky soil that comes from air pollution, cooking vapors and life's daily activities.
- Some vinyl manufacturers recommend a polish where others recommend a refresher for periodic maintenance. To help maintain the beauty of your floor, please refer to your manufacturer's recommendations.

SPILL & STAIN REMOVAL

- For stubborn stains, spot clean with a concentrated cleaner as recommended by your vinyl's manufacturer. Do not use products containing bleach that can damage your floor.
- When cleaning your vinyl flooring, always use a clean white towel to be sure to avoid spreading or adding to the stain.
